SENATE BILL 582

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §27-35-203(i) TO REMOVE WEIGHT EXEMPTIONS FOR HAULING SAND, GRAVEL, ROCK OR CRUSHED STONE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO AMEND A.C.A. § 27-35-203(i) TO REMOVE WEIGHT EXEMPTIONS FOR HAULING SAND, GRAVEL, ROCK OR CRUSHED STONE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-35-203(i) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(i)(1) Vehicles or combinations of vehicles with five (5) axles hauling unfinished and unprocessed farm products, forest products, or other products of the soil shall be exempt from the federal bridge formula found in subsection (e) of this section on noninterstate highways in this state.

(2) Vehicles, or combinations of vehicles, with five (5) axles hauling unfinished and unprocessed farm products, forest products, or other products of the soil shall comply with a tandem axle limit of thirty-six thousand five hundred pounds (36,500 lbs) and a single axle limit of twenty thousand pounds (20,000 lbs), provided, no tandem axle shall exceed thirty-four thousand pounds (34,000 lbs) while operated on the federal interstate highways of this state.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
