SENATE BILL 6

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-409 TO ADD AN
ADDITIONAL SUBSECTION CONCERNING THE MAILING OF AN
ABSENTEE BALLOT TO AN APPLICANT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Subtitle

"AN ACT CONCERNING THE MAILING OF AN
ABSENTEE BALLOT TO AN APPLICANT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-409 is amended to add an additional
subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c)(1) Except for absentee ballots mailed to an address outside the
county in which the applicant is registered, an absentee ballot shall be
mailed to the address that appears on the applicant's *registration record*.

(2) The clerk shall not mail more than five (5) absentee ballots
to the same address unless:

(A) the address is outside the territorial limits of the
United States and the District of Columbia;

(B) the address is for a long term care or residential care
facility licensed by the state;

(C) there are more than five (5) persons lawfully
registered at the same address."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
