# A Bill

SENATE BILL 604

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING SEWER SERVICE MAY REQUEST AN ASSOCIATION OR IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PROVIDING THE WATER SERVICE TO TERMINATE WATER SERVICE TO A CUSTOMER WHO IS DELINQUENT IN MAKING SEWER PAYMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO ALLOW WATER ASSOCIATIONS OR IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS TO TERMINATE WATER SERVICE TO ANY PERSON WHO OWES A MUNICIPALITY FOR SEWER SERVICE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Any municipality owning or operating a public sewer system or sewer improvement district providing sewer service to its citizens may request a water association or water improvement district providing the water service to terminate the water service to any resident who is delinquent at least thirty (30) days in making payment to the municipality for sewer service.

(b) The water association or water improvement district shall terminate the water service upon certification by the municipality that the person is more than thirty (30) days delinquent in making payments for sewer service and has been sent notice of the termination of the water service by the municipality.

(c) The water association or water improvement district shall send notice to any person who is delinquent in making payments for sewer service of the date the water service will be terminated and shall terminate the

1 water service upon that date unless the balance due the municipality for  
2 sewer service has been paid.

4       SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8       SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
12 act are declared to be severable.

14       SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
15 hereby repealed.
