8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COMMISSION ON LAW
9 ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING FOR CONSTRUCTION, MAJOR
10 MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION, AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASES; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE COMMISSION ON LAW
15 ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING
16 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
21 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
23 following:

24 (A) For the purchase of a hardwired fire and smoke detection and alarm
25 system, the sum of \$ 66,000.

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27 (B) For the purchase of a phone system, the sum of \$18,290.

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29 (C) For major maintenance, renovation, and repair of classrooms, the
30 sum of \$ 154,000.

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32 (D) For the installation and purchase of a fingerprint laboratory and
33 equipment, the sum of \$ 138,560.

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35 (E) For the purchase of video and classroom projection equipment, the

1 sum of \$ 27,500.

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3 (F) For the purchase of audio equipment, the sum of \$ 27,500.

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5 (G) For constructing and equipping a laundry facility, the sum
6 of \$ 50,000.

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8 (H) For the purchase of kitchen equipment, the sum of \$ 15,000.

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10 (I) For the purchase of physical fitness training equipment, the sum
11 of \$ 86,350.

12 (J) For constructing and equipping a Driver Training/Hazard Course at
13 the Law Enforcement Training Academy - East Camden, the
14 sum of

15 \$500,000.

16 (K) For constructing and equipping a dormitory in East Camden, the sum
17 of \$3,700,000

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20 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
21 Southern Arkansas University - TECH - to be payable from the General
22 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

23 (A) For expenses of the SAU-Tech Fire Training Academy satellite
24 at Jonesboro, the sum of \$
25 50,000.

26 (B) For constructing, equipping and associated costs of an Engineering
27 Building, the sum of

28 \$1,200,000

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30 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
31 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
32 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
33 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
34 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
35 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

1 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
2 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
3 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
4 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
5 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
6 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

7 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
8 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
9 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
10 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
11 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
12 disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided
13 otherwise by law.

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15 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
17 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
18 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
25 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
26 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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28 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
29 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
30 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
31 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
32 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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34 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
35 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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2 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
3 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
4 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;
5 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the
6 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
7 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
8 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
9 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
10 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
11 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
13 July 1, 1995.
