8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
9 CORRECTION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY PUNISHMENT FOR
10 CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION, REPAIR, EQUIPPING,
11 OPERATING AND CONTRACTING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION
15 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
20 appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from the General
21 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

22 (A) For the purchase of Refrigerant Recovery Units, the sum
23 of \$37,500.

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25 (B) For expenses associated with the installation of Fire Alarm
26 Systems at the Cummins, Tucker and Pine Bluff Units, the sum of ... \$280,000.

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28 (C) For the completion of construction of the Varner Unit, the sum
29 of \$440,000.

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31 (D) For roofing renovations and replacements at the Pine Bluff,
32 Cummins and Diagnostic Units and the Central Administration Office, the sum
33 of \$329,131.

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35 (E) For Wastewater Treatment Improvements at the North Central Unit

- 1 and the Training Academy, the sum of \$262,000.
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- 3 (F) For construction of a records expansion area at the Diagnostic
4 Unit, the sum of \$136,000.
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- 6 (G) For kitchen renovations and purchase of equipment at the various
7 units, the sum of \$396,450.
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- 9 (H) For purchase of laundry equipment at the various units, the sum of
10 \$107,000.
11
- 12 (I) For expenses of a larger fire hydrant and service line for the
13 Administration and freeline areas in Pine Bluff, the sum of \$8,000.
14
- 15 (J) For expenses associated with the water well project at the East
16 Arkansas Unit, the sum of \$400,000.
17
- 18 (K) For expenses associated with the replacement of the electronic
19 system at the Cummins Unit, the sum of \$100,000.
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- 21 (L) For expenses associated with a 200-bed addition to the North
22 Central Unit, the sum of \$1,418,917.
23
- 24 (M) For expenses associated with providing for a 576-bed Intake
25 Facility at a location to be determined, the sum of \$20,640,585.
26
- 27 (N) For expenses associated with providing a 600-bed (metal building)
28 unit at a location to be determined, the sum of \$13,920,000.

- 30 (O) For expenses associated with providing the 600-bed unit - East
31 Camden Project, the sum of \$8,657,133.
32
- 33 (P) For equipment acquisition at various new facilities, the sum
34 of \$1,184,394.
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1 (Q) For expenses associated with adding a 300-bed modular unit at
2 Cummins, the sum of \$2,334,150.

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4 (R) For expenses associated with the garment expansion project at the
5 East Arkansas Unit, the sum of \$1,091,625.

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7 (S) For expenses associated with the Furniture Program Expansion
8 Project at the Wrightsville Unit, the sum of \$537,000.

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10 (T) For expenses associated with the Printing Program Expansion
11 Project at the Wrightsville Unit, the sum of \$523,888.

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13 (U) For expenses associated with the Metal Fabrication Expansion
14 Project at the Tucker Unit, the sum of \$144,020.

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16 (V) For expenses associated with the Upholstery/Component Chairs
17 Expansion Program, the sum of \$1,128,520.

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19 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
20 appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Community Punishment, to be
21 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
22 accounts, the following:

23 (A) For constructing, renovating and equipping various community
24 correctional facilities, the sum of \$8,000,000.

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26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
27 appropriated, to the Department of Correction and the Arkansas Department of
28 Community Punishment, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
29 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

30 (A) For the purpose of providing for the construction, renovation,
31 equipping, contracting and operation of various institutional facilities
32 administered by the Department of Correction and/or the Department of
33 Community Punishment, the sum of \$60,000,000.

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35 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
13 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
14 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
15 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
17 disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided
18 otherwise by law.

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20 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
30 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
31 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;
10 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the
11 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
12 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
13 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
14 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
15 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
16 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
17 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
18 July 1, 1995.

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
