8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 25-15-104(a)(1) TO GRANT
9 SUBPOENA POWERS TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTION
10 COMMISSIONERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "TO GRANT SUBPOENA POWERS TO THE STATE
14 BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-15-104(a)(1) is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 "(a)(1) The following boards and commissions shall have the power to
21 issue subpoenas and bring before the board or commission as a witness any
22 person in this state:

23 (A) Auctioneers Licensing Board, § 17-15-201 et seq.;

24 (B) State Athletic Commission, § 17-19-201 et seq.;

25 (C) State Board of Cosmetology, § 17-23-201 et seq.;

26 (D) Arkansas Board of Examiners in Counseling, § 17-24-101 et seq.;

27 (E) State Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors, § 17-26-201, et
28 seq.;

29 (F) Advisory Committee for Registration of Landscape Architects in the
30 State of Arkansas, § 17-29-101 et seq.;

31 (G) The Committee of Plumbing Examiners of the State Board of Health,
32 § 17-31-202 et seq.;

33 (H) Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board, § 17-39-201 et seq.;

34 (I) Arkansas Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration
35 (HVACR) Licensing Board, § 17-50-101 and § 17-50-201 et seq.;

1 (J) Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, § 15-75-201 et seq.;
2 (K) Arkansas Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission, Amendment
3 66, Arkansas Constitution, and § 16-10-401 et seq.;
4 (L) Veterinary Medical Examining Board, § 17-99-201 et seq.;
5 (M) Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians, § 17-88-201 et seq.; and
6 (N) State Board of Election Commissioners."

7

8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

11

12 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

17

18 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.
