SENATE BILL 695

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 12-12-1005 TO ALLOW THE
9 IDENTIFICATION BUREAU TO CHARGE A FEE FOR FINGERPRINT
10 CARDS USED FOR NON-CRIMINAL JUSTICE PURPOSES; TO AMEND
11 ARKANSAS CODE § 12-12-1012 TO PROVIDE THAT FEES COLLECTED
12 BY THE IDENTIFICATION BUREAU MAY BE USED FOR THE
13 MAINTENANCE AND EXPANSION OF AN AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT
14 IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "ALLOW IDENTIFICATION BUREAU TO CHARGE A
17 FEE FOR FINGERPRINT CARDS USED FOR NON-
18 CRIMINAL JUSTICE PURPOSES; TO PROVIDE
19 THAT FEES COLLECTED BE USED FOR
20 MAINTENANCE & EXPANSION OF AN AUTOMATED
21 FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM."

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1005 is amended by inserting an
27 additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:

28 "(d) When the Identification Bureau is requested by a person to make
29 fingerprint cards for the use of the person for non-criminal justice
30 purposes, the Identification Bureau may charge a fee for making such
31 fingerprint cards. The amount of such fee will be determined by the
32 Identification Bureau but shall not exceed ten dollars (\$10.00). All fees
33 collected under this subsection shall be deposited immediately in the State
34 Treasury as special revenues to the credit of the State Police Equipment
35 Fund. Special revenues deposited in the State Police Equipment Funds and

1 unused at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward."

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3 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1012(b)(1) is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "(b)(1) All fees shall be deposited immediately in the State Treasury
6 as special revenue to the credit of the State Police Equipment Fund, which is
7 hereby created on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and
8 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, there to be used for the acquisition,
9 maintenance and expansion of an automated fingerprint identification system."

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11 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
12 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
13 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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15 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 act are declared to be severable.

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21 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
22 hereby repealed.

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
