18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 2-16-701 is hereby amended to
21 read as follows:

22 "2-16-701. Creation.

23 (a) The Arkansas Fire Ant Advisory Board is hereby created to accept
24 all gifts, grants, and other moneys from any source for the purpose of
25 financing new and ongoing fire ant research and educational programs and
26 providing counsel in planning and executing such research and educational
27 programs.

28 (b) Said moneys will route through the University of Arkansas
29 Agricultural Experiment Station, the University of Arkansas Cooperative
30 Extension Service, or the University of Arkansas Agricultural Development
31 Council at Fayetteville for use by the Fire Ant Advisory Board and fire ant
32 researchers in the Department of Forest Resources at the University of
33 Arkansas at Monticello or other researchers in cooperative efforts with
34 researchers at the University of Arkansas at Monticello."

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4
5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
