# A Bill

SENATE BILL 725

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-57-223 PERTAINING TO  
SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF LICENSES ISSUED TO SELL  
TOBACCO PRODUCTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-57-223  
PERTAINING TO SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION  
OF LICENSES ISSUED TO SELL TOBACCO  
PRODUCTS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-57-223 is amended to read as follows:

"26-57-223. Permits and licenses - Suspension or revocation.

All permits and licenses issued under this subchapter may be suspended or  
revoked by the director for any serious or repeated violation of this  
subchapter or the regulations pertaining thereto. *For a first offense the  
director may suspend a permit or license for up to one week, for a second  
offense the director may suspend a permit or license for up to thirty (30)  
days, and for a third or subsequent offense the director may suspend a permit  
or license for up to one year.*"

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.
