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For An Act To Be Entitled

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8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT UPON THE DISSOLUTION OF ANY
9 CORPORATION CURRENTLY LICENSED TO PROVIDE HOME HEALTH CARE
10 SERVICES, REGULATORY AGENCIES MAY TRANSFER THE
11 CORPORATION'S PERMITS OF APPROVAL AND LICENSES TO A
12 SHAREHOLDER OF THE CORPORATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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15 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT UPON THE
16 DISSOLUTION OF ANY CORPORATION CURRENTLY
17 LICENSED TO PROVIDE HOME HEALTH CARE
18 SERVICES, REGULATORY AGENCIES MAY
19 TRANSFER THE CORPORATION'S PERMITS OF
20 APPROVAL AND LICENSES TO A SHAREHOLDER
21 OF THE CORPORATION."

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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26 SECTION 1. Upon the dissolution of any corporation which on the
27 effective date of this act is licensed to provide home health care services,
28 the Health Department, the Health Services Agency, the Health Services
29 Commission, and any other agency involved may transfer the dissolved
30 corporation's licenses and permits of approval to a stockholder of the
31 dissolved corporation and that stockholder may continue to perform home
32 health care services under the transferred license and permit of approval.

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34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

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9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.

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12 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
13 General Assembly that home health care services should be dealt with by the
14 private sector obtaining licenses or permits of approval from any agency of
15 the state; that this act so provides; and this act should go into effect as
16 soon as possible in order to maximize home health care services throughout
17 this state. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
18 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
19 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
20 approval.
