13 "TO REQUIRE MOMENTS OF *SILENCE* IN PUBLIC
14 SCHOOL CLASSROOMS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The General Assembly hereby finds
19 that in today's hectic society, few citizens are able to experience even a
20 moment of silence before beginning the day's activities. The young people of
21 Arkansas are particularly affected by this absence of an opportunity for a
22 moment of silence. The General Assembly further finds that our young people,
23 and society as a whole, would be well served if students were afforded a
24 moment of silence at the beginning of each day in the public schools.

25

26 SECTION 2. (a) Beginning with the 1995-96 school year, each school
27 district in the state shall provide for a daily observance by pupils of a
28 brief period of silence. The moment of silence shall be for a period of not
29 more than five (5) minutes each morning with the participation of all
30 pupils.

31

32 district in the state shall adopt procedures for implementing the moment of
33 silence and shall file a copy with the Director of the Department of
34 Education.

35

1 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
