8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE - VOTER
10 REGISTRATION SYSTEM WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1068 OF 1993;
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is hereby established for the Secretary of State - Voter Registration System, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Act 1068 of 1993 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is
6 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State
7 Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
8 Secretary of State - Voter Registration System which shall be supplemental
9 and in addition to those funds appropriated in Act 1068 of 1993, the
10 following:

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25 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
26 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
28 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
3 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
10 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
11 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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19 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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22 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for
24 the operations of the Secretary of State are, due to unforeseen
25 circumstances, insufficient for the Secretary of State to continue to provide
26 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
27 the necessary monies for the Secretary of State to continue such services;
28 and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable
29 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
33 passage and approval.

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
