8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL DIVISION FOR
11 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ADMINISTRATION. There is hereby established for the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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23 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - ENFORCEMENT. There is hereby
 24 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic
 25 Beverage Control Enforcement Division, to be payable from the State General
 26 Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 27 Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control
 28 Enforcement Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the

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13 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 14 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 16 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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23 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 25 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 26 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
 33 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
 34 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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1 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
4 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
5 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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7 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
8 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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10 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
11 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
12 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
13 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
14 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
15 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
16 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
17 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
18 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
19 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
20 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
21 July 1, 1995.
