SENATE BILL 793

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 19-4-1008(a) AND (b) TO
9 MAKE ADVANCES OF EXPENSE FUNDS FOR AUTHORIZED TRAVEL BY
10 STUDENTS OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO MAKE ADVANCED OF EXPENSE
15 FUNDS FOR AUTHORIZES TRAVEL BY STUDENTS
16 OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-1008(a) and (b) is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(a) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is authorized to promulgate
23 appropriate rules and regulations authorizing state agencies, boards,
24 commissions, and institutions of higher learning to establish revolving funds
25 which shall be within such limitations as the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
26 State may prescribe. These funds shall be used to make advances of expense
27 funds for authorized travel by officials and employees of state agencies,
28 boards, commissions, and institutions of higher learning whose travel is in
29 conjunction with institutionally sponsored events or programs. These funds
30 shall be reimbursed by the individual borrowing the funds from moneys to the
31 individual upon filing his authorized expense account in connection with his
32 travel.

33 (b) The regulations may authorize the state agencies, boards,
34 commissions, and institutions of higher learning to require the employee to
35 file an agreement authorizing the agency to recover any amounts advanced for

1 travel expense purposes from the amounts claimed and allowed the employee or
2 student as reimbursement for actual expenses incurred, to recover them from
3 the next or future salary payments to the employee, or add to them to the
4 receivables account of the student."

5

6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
