For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 11, CHAPTER 6 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE
8 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF HOURS THAT
9 STUDENTS MAY WORK WHILE ENROLLED IN SCHOOL AND TO REQUIRE
10 EMPLOYERS TO PERIODICALLY FILE AFFIDAVITS WITH SCHOOL
11 PRINCIPALS IN REGARD TO STUDENT WORKING HOURS; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "TO AMEND TITLE 11, CHAPTER 6 OF THE
16 ARKANSAS CODE TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF
17 HOURS THAT STUDENTS MAY WORK WHILE
18 ENROLLED IN SCHOOL."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22

23 SECTION 1. Title 11, Chapter 6 of the Arkansas Code Annotated is
24 hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

25 "11-6-115.

26 (a) No student enrolled in school shall be employed to work more than
27 twenty-one (21) hours during any week that school is in session.

28 (b) At the end of each grading period, a person, firm, or corporation
29 employing a student shall file an affidavit verifying the student's working
30 hours with the principal of the student's school.

31 (c) Any person, firm, corporation, parent, guardian, or custodian who
32 employs a student, fails to file an affidavit, or permits any student to work
33 in violation of this section shall be subject to penalties as prescribed in
34 § 11-6-103."

35

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
