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For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING
9 EXPENSES FOR THE PREVENTION OF AVIAN INFLUENZA FOR THE LIVESTOCK
10 AND POULTRY COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1174 OF 1993; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

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16 "AN ACT FOR THE LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Livestock
23 and Poultry Commission - Egg Grading for the 1993-95 biennium, the following
24 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
25 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Three (3)
26 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
27 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
28 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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30 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - EGG GRADING. There is hereby
31 appropriated, to the Livestock and Poultry Commission, to be payable from the
32 Poultry and Egg Grading Fund Account, for personal services and operating
33 expenses for the Prevention of Avian Influenza into the Arkansas Poultry
34 Industry which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
35 appropriated in Section 8 of Act 1174 of 1993, the following:

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9 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
29 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
30 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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32 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in
4 conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined
7 by the Eightieth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Ninth
8 General Assembly for the Livestock and Poultry Commission are, due to
9 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Livestock and Poultry
10 Commission to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
11 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Livestock
12 and Poultry Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in the
13 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
14 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
15 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
16 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
17 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
