8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM  
10 - HISTORY COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
11 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND  
14 TOURISM - HISTORY COMMISSION  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE. There is hereby established for  
21 the Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission - State for the  
22 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
23 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification  
24 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,  
25 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to  
26 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be  
27 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation  
28 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed  
29 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act  
30 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

20 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the

21 Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission - Cash, to be payable

22 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of

23 Parks and Tourism - History Commission, for operating expenses of the

24 Department of Parks and Tourism - History Commission - Cash for the biennial

25 period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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5 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
6 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
7 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
8 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
17 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
18 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
25 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
26 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

27

28 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
29 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
30 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
31 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
32 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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34 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
35 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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2           SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by  
3 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
4 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
5 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to  
6 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
7 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
8 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work  
9 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
10 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
11 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
12 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after  
13 July 1, 1995.
