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Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR - OPERATIONS. There
20 is hereby established for the Department of Labor for the 1995-97 biennium,
21 the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
22 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
23 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
24 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
25 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
26 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
27 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
28 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
29 101), or its successor.

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18 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

19 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

21 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

31 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 11. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 13. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
