17 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the state of
18 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly
19 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of
20 two-thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

21 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Eightieth
22 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this
23 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will
24 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session,

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
28 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

30 That the regular session of the Eightieth General Assembly of the state
31 of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each house on
32 Friday, March 24, 1995, at which time the 1995 regular session shall be
33 adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is
34 necessary to complete the business of the session.
