15 URGING BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF U OF A TO NAME FORESTRY
16 BUILDINGS AT U OF A - MONTICELLO THE "H. H. HANK
17 CHAMBERLIN FOREST RESOURCES COMPLEX".

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Henry H. "Hank" Chamberlin was first employed by Arkansas
20 A & M College in 1945 to establish the first forestry collegiate program in
21 the State; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Chamberlin initiated a two-year degree program in forestry
23 in 1945 and in 1949 he initiated a four-year degree program which remains the
24 forestry baccalaureate degree program for Arkansas today; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Chamberlin presided as professor and head of the forestry
26 program until 1972 and continued to teach in the program until 1980; and

27 WHEREAS, Professor Chamberlin has the distinction of having taught
28 every Arkansas forestry student from 1945 through 1980, a period during which
29 almost 600 students graduated with forestry degrees; and

30 WHEREAS, Mr. H. H. "Hank" Chamberlin is truly the "Father of Forestry
31 Education" in Arkansas and he is most deserving of having the forestry
32 buildings at the University of Arkansas at Monticello named in his honor,
