17 WHEREAS, Mr. Sam Hindsman retired on July 31, 1992, after having served  
18 as Director of the Arkansas Bureau of Standards and its predecessor, the  
19 Division of Weights and Measures, for nineteen years; and

21 WHEREAS, prior to his appointment to the position of Director of the  
22 Division of Weights and Measures by Governor Dale Bumpers in 1973, Mr.  
23 Hindsman served as instructor and head basketball coach from 1944 to 1947 at  
24 the institution that is now the University of Central Arkansas, and head of  
25 the Department of Health, Physical Education and Recreation, and head  
26 basketball coach at Arkansas Tech from 1947 to 1966; and

28 WHEREAS, Coach Hindsman was named NAIA "Coach of the Year" in 1954, and  
29 in 1981 he was inducted into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame; and

31 WHEREAS, during his service as Director of the Arkansas Bureau of  
32 Standards, Sam Hindsman served in many regional and national positions of  
33 honor and trust, including Chairman of the National Conference on Weights and  
34 Measures, Chairman of the National Task Force on Grain Moisture Meter  
35 Assurance, National Conference on Weights and Measures representative to the

1 International Organization of Legal Metrology, and Chairman of the Southern  
2 Weights and Measures Association; and

4 WHEREAS, during his service in State government, Mr. Sam Hindsman  
5 brought national recognition and honor to the State of Arkansas and was  
6 instrumental in the establishment of the Arkansas Bureau of Standards which  
7 is recognized as one of the leading Bureau of Standards in the country; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Sam Hindsman, who is the father of Ann Cornwell, Secretary  
10 of the Senate, is ill and in the hospital and the members of the Senate wish  
11 to express appreciation to and commend Mr. Hindsman for his service to the  
12 State and to express best wishes for his speedy recovery,
