13 WHEREAS, United States Senator Hattie W. Caraway was the first woman in
14 the nation to be elected to the United States Senate; and

15 WHEREAS, Senator Caraway served as United States Senator from Arkansas
16 from 1931 through 1944; and

17 WHEREAS, Senator Caraway was the first woman to preside over the United
18 States Senate; and

19 WHEREAS, Senator Caraway was the first woman to chair a Senate
20 Committee, the Committee on Enrolled Bills; and

21 WHEREAS, upon leaving the United States Senate, Senator Caraway served
22 as a member of the United States Employees Compensation Commission and later
23 on the Employees Compensation Appeals Board; and

24 WHEREAS, the United States Commission on Art has determined that
25 Senator Caraway is an appropriate subject for the collection of commemorative
26 portraits to be hung in our nation_s Capitol; and

27 WHEREAS, Mrs. Betty Bumpers and Mrs. Barbara Pryor are serving as
28 honorary co-chairs of a committee to honor Senator Caraway and to commission
29 a portrait of Senator Caraway to be displayed in the United States Capitol;
30 and

31 WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the State of Arkansas to recognize the
32 accomplishments of Senator Hattie W. Caraway on the occasion of the unveiling
33 of her portrait.
