## For An Act To Be Entitled


#### Abstract

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-52-518 TO PROVIDE THAT PROMOTERS OR ORGANIZERS OF SPECIAL EVENTS SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO REGISTER AS A SPECIAL EVENTS PROMOTER OR OTHERWISE COMPLY WITH THE SPECIAL EVENTS LAW IF THE PROMOTER DOES NOT PROMOTE MORE THAN ONE SPECIAL EVENT PER YEAR AND THE SPECIAL EVENT HAS ONE HUNDRED OR FEWER VENDORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

"TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FOR PROMOTERS OR ORGANIZERS OF SPECIAL EVENTS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-52-518 is amended by adding a new paragraph (g) to read as follows:
"(g) The promoter or organizer of a special event shall be exempt from the provisions of this section if:
(1) the promoter or organizer does not organize, promote, or otherwise present more than one (1) special event during any calendar year; and
(2) one hundred (100) or fewer special event vendors display or exhibit merchandise for sale at a special event organized, promoted, or presented by the promoter or organizer."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
