Legislative Findings and Intent. The General Assembly finds 24 25 that the State of Arkansas has provided encouragement and the financial means 26 to build a foundation for an information technology network linking local 27 school districts and the State Department of Education. The General Assembly 28 further finds that the amount of information that local school districts and 29 their personnel are required to furnish the department, while essential, has 30 become increasingly burdensome. The General Assembly therefore expresses its 31 intent and commitment to ensuring that the State Department of Education 32 utilize and continually upgrade to the fullest extent possible the information 33 technology network linking the various school districts and the department. 34 35 SECTION 2. (a) The State Board of Education, acting through the State

1 amount of paperwork required by state law and regulation to be reported from

- 2 each local school district by utilizing to the fullest extent possible,
- 3 beginning no later than July 1, 1998, the information technology network
- 4 linking local school districts and the department.
- 5 (b) The Director of the General Education Division of the State
- 6 Department of Education shall report on the progress of implementing the
- 7 provisions of subsection (a) to the members of the House and Senate Interim
- 8 Education Committees by no later than October 1, 1998.

- 10 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 11 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 12 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 14 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 15 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 16 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 17 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 18 act are declared to be severable.

- 20 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 21 hereby repealed.
