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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23	SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The General Assembly finds and
24	acknowledges that, while character and citizenship education is primarily a
25	parental responsibility, it must not remain isolated there. The General
26	Assembly further finds that the removal of character and citizenship
27	components from traditional education has left a void as yet unfilled, with
28	many young people experiencing frustration at having to deal with the social
29	order of today.
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31	SECTION 2. (a) The Director of the General Education Division of the
32	Department of Education shall develop materials for teaching character and
33	citizenship for inclusion in the curriculum for all kindergarten through grade
34	twelve (K-12) students in the public schools of the state of Arkansas.
35	(b) The director shall ensure that these materials are reproduced and
36	sent to all school districts in the state by no later than August 1, 1998, and

1 are updated after each regular session of the General Assembly.

(c) During each interim of the biennium, the director shall provide a 3 progress report on the implementation and effectiveness of this act to the 4 members of the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education. SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 7 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 8 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 14 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 17 hereby repealed.
