BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
SECTION 1. Gross receipts or gross proceeds derived from the sale or repair of communications devices designed to assist persons with hearing impairments, such as hearing aids, telecommunications equipment for the deaf, and other devices for those with hearing impairments, including repair parts and supplies for such items, shall be exempt from the Arkansas Gross Receipts Tax Act (Arkansas Code §26-52-101 et seq.) and the Arkansas Compensating Use Tax Act (Arkansas Code \(\$ 26-53-101\) et seq.), and all other state and local sales and use taxes.
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
