6 (2) Inmates who are reduced to the lowest class, established 7 through board policy, as a result of disciplinary action shall not be entitled 8 to earn meritorious good time.

9 (3) Inmates serving a punitive disciplinary sentence in punitive 10 segregation shall not be entitled to earn meritorious good time.

11 (c) Meritorious good time will be allotted to each inmate on a monthly 12 basis in accordance with their classification. such that the inmate receives 13 one (1) day for every day served, not to exceed thirty (30) days per month.

14 (d) Inmates may be reclassified as often as the committee deems 15 necessary or in accordance with current board regulations to carry out the 16 purpose of this subchapter and to maintain good discipline, order, and 17 efficiency at the units, facilities, or centers."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

23 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 26 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 27 act are declared to be severable.
