## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-53-108 TO EXTEND  
10 OPTIONAL PROVISIONS FOR PROVIDING UNIFORM SICK LEAVE TO  
11 ALL CITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

14 "TO EXTEND OPTIONAL PROVISIONS FOR  
15 PROVIDING UNIFORM SICK LEAVE TO ALL  
16 CITIES."

17  
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-53-108(d) is amended to read as follows:

21 "(d) Cities of the first class, cities of the second class and  
22 incorporated towns ~~with populations of over seventy thousand (70,000) citizens~~  
23 shall have the option of providing sick leave for fire fighters to accumulate  
24 at a rate of fifteen (15) working days per year beginning with the date of  
25 employment and decreasing to twelve (12) working days beginning four (4) years  
26 after employment. Unused sick leave shall accumulate to fire fighters  
27 provided with fifteen (15) and twelve (12) working days per year sick leave to  
28 a maximum of one hundred (100) days."

29  
30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33  
34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
