1 2 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 3 hereby repealed. 5 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General 6 Assembly that the food service establishment permit fee provided for in 7 Arkansas Code §20-57-204 expires on July 1, 1997; that the fee should 8 continue; and that unless this emergency clause is enacted the fee will expire 9 prior to the effective date of this act. Therefore an emergency is declared 10 to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the 11 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its 12 approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the 13 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time 14 during which the Governor may veto the bill.
