Therefore, an 8 emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for 9 the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective 10 on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved 11 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the 12 period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.
