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18	WHEREAS, the public employees retirement system is not able to maximize
19	interest earnings capability under the current system of processing vouchers
20	for retirees; and
21	WHEREAS, it is the intent of this act to allow the public employees
22	retirement system to process retiree benefit vouchers in a manner which will
23	improve the interest earnings capability of their funds; and
24	WHEREAS, the acceptable proposed method of financing public employees
25	retirement funds will require the auditor of state to issue paper or
26	electronic warrants for retiree benefits without regard to balances in the
27	state treasury funds, but the state treasurer shall have sufficient balances
28	on hand in order to redeem these warrants.
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30	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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32	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-1107 (b) is amended by inserting an
33	additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:
34	"(D) In the case of vouchers written upon the Public Employees
35	Retirement System funds for retiree benefits, the Auditor of State shall
36	process paper or electronic warrants to pay the vouchers upon certification by

1 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that funds are available from the Public 2 Employees Retirement System funds with which to pay the warrants when they 3 shall be presented for payment." All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 5 SECTION 2. 6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 8 9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 13 act are declared to be severable. 14 15 SECTION 4.
