21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the State Forestry Commission's law
24 enforcement personnel to enforce the Poison Springs State Forest regulations
25 promulgated by the State Forestry Commission pursuant to the Administrative
26 Procedures Act, § 25-15-201 et seq. The State Forestry Commission's law
27 enforcement personnel shall have the right to take the offenders before any
28 court having jurisdiction in the county where the offense is committed.
29 Violations of Poison Springs State Forest regulations shall be considered
30 unclassified misdemeanors, the penalty for which shall be in accordance with
31 the regulation defining the conduct, but in no case shall the penalty for
32 violating any Poison Springs State Forest regulation exceed the penalty
33 established by law for a Class A misdemeanor.

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act of the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
