For the biennium ending June 30, 1999, the sum of the appropriations for the Emergency Fire Trust Fund and the State Forest Trust 5 Fund shall apply to the State Forestry Trust Fund. 6 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 7 8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 10 11 SECTION 7. 28 administration and provision of essential governmental programs and would

29 impede the Forestry Commission from complying with the policy of the State of

30 Arkansas as set out in Arkansas Code ⁶ 19-4-509. Therefore, an emergency is

31 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate

32 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and

33 effect from and after July 1, 1997.
