26	of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) and which is sold to or used by persons	3
27	engaged primarily in the growing and harvesting of timber and which is used	<u>t</u>
28	exclusively in site preparation, planting, cultivating, and harvesting time	oer.
29	(b) The taxes levied under the Arkansas Gross Receipts Tax Act	
30	(Arkansas Code 26-52-101 et seq.) and the Arkansas Compensating Tax Act	
31	(Arkansas Code 26-53-101 et seq.) with respect to the sale of timber	
32	harvesting implements shall apply only to that portion of the sales price i	<u>in</u>
33	excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for each implement sold.

35	SECTION 2. The Department of Finance and Administration shall	
36	promulgate regulations necessary to implement this act and to assure taxpay	yer
