12 RIVERS COMPREHENSIVE LIFELONG LEARNING CENTER - EUDORA  
13 CENTER FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND  
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - Eudora Center. There is hereby established for the Department of Education -  
25 Great Rivers Comprehensive Lifelong Learning Center - Eudora Center for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of regular  
26 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
27 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
28 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
29 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
30 or its successor.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - Eudora Center. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Great Rivers  
5 Comprehensive Lifelong Learning Center - Eudora Center for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
6 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Four (4) temporary or part-time employees,  
7 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
8 appropriate classification.

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10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - Eudora Center. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Great  
11 Rivers Comprehensive Lifelong Learning Center - Eudora Center, to be payable from the Vocational-Technical Schools Fund Account, for  
12 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Great Rivers Comprehensive Lifelong Learning Center - Eudora  
13 Center for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

28 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the  
29 appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State  
30 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and  
31 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department  
32 of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority  
35 of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the

1 Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of  
2 Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
3 Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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5 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987  
6 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
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8 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held  
9 invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or  
10 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.  
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12 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.  
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14 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly, that the  
15 Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act  
16 on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an  
17 extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
18 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary  
19 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.  
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
