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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the

Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department

of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2	Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget

5	SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987
6	Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
7	
8	SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
9	invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or
10	application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
11	
12	SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
13	
14	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly, that the
15	Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act
16	on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an
17	extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
18	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary
19	for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
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
