### For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO STATE AGENCY MAY ENTER INTO ANY  
10 INTERSTATE *COMPACT* OR AGREEMENT PRIOR TO ITS BEING  
11 REVIEWED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

15 "TO PROVIDE THAT NO STATE AGENCY MAY  
16 ENTER INTO ANY INTERSTATE *COMPACT* OR  
17 AGREEMENT PRIOR TO IT BEING REVIEWED BY  
18 THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Any compact and agreement contemplated by an agency of this  
23 state between it and an agency of another state shall be submitted to the  
24 Legislative Council for review at least thirty (30) days prior to its  
25 execution. This provision shall not apply to interstate compacts or  
26 agreements between the constitutional offices of Governor, Lieutenant  
27 Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, Auditor of State, Treasurer of  
28 State, and Commissioner of State Lands and an agency of another state, or to  
29 agreements entered into by the Arkansas State Highway Commission, Arkansas  
30 State Highway and Transportation Department, the Arkansas Game and Fish  
31 Commission, the Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism, or the Arkansas Game  
32 and Fish Commission. The Legislative Council may establish a procedure to  
33 expedite review of such proposed compacts or agreements.  
34

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
10 hereby repealed.
