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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-57-310 is amended by inserting an				
20	additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:				
21	" $(h)(1)$ Upon the effective date of this act, any person owning or				
22	operating an unpermitted stream bed mining operation who is required to obtain				
23	such a permit by this subchapter or regulations promulgated pursuant to this				
24	subchapter shall be assessed, at a minimum, a one thousand dollar (\$1,000)				
25	penalty and ordered by the department to cease operations until the necessary				
26	permits are issued. The failure to cease operations before obtaining the				
27	necessary state permits ordered shall be grounds for subsequent enforcement				
28	action, including fines. The fact that the alleged violator has obtained a				
29	permit from the U. S. Corps of Engineers shall not be a defense to any				
30	enforcement action brought by the department pursuant to this subchapter.				
31	(2) Upon the effective date of this act, any person owning or				
32	operating an unpermitted open-cut sand or gravel operation adjacent to a				
33	stream in this state shall be assessed, at a minimum, a five hundred dollar				
34	(\$500) penalty and ordered by the department to cease operations until the				
35	necessary permits are issued. The failure to cease operations before				
36	obtaining the ne	ecessary state permits ordered shall be gro	unds for subsea	uent	

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1	enforcement action, including fines.		
2	(3) In no event shall the owner or operator of a sand and gravel		
3	mining operation remove materials from a stream bed, whether dry or flowing,		
4	in such a manner as to deepen the channel or alter its established course.		
5	Any owner or operator conducting such removal operations shall be subject to		
6	the full extent of liabilities established by this subchapter.		
7	(4) This section shall not be construed to prevent the U.S. Army		
8	Corps of Engineers from issuing 404 permits to prevent flooding.		
9	(5) All reports required to be filed with the Department of		
10	Pollution Control and Ecology or the Pollution Control and Ecology Commission		
11	shall also be filed with the House Committee on Agricultural and Economic		
12	Development and the Senate Committee on Agricultural, Economic and Industrial		
13	Development."		
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15	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
16	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
17	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		

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19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 23 act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 26 hereby repealed.
