- 32 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity
- 33 shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can
- 34 be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to
- 35 this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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1	SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act	
2	are hereby repealed.	
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4	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the	
5	General Assembly that unless the General Assembly acts, the impairment	
6	rating guide adopted by the Workers_ Compensation Commission will become	
7	null and void on March 1, 1997; that if the guide is permitted to	
8	expire, there will be no impairment guide in effect and injured workers	
9	may be deprived of just benefits; that the purpose and intent of this	
10	act is to approve the impairment guide adopted by the commission and the	
11	act should be given effect immediately to assure that there will be no	
12	lapse in the application of the impairment rating guide. Therefore an	
13	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary	
14	for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become	
15	effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is	
16	neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective	
17	on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may	
18	veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
19	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house	
20	overrides the veto.
