19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32 SECTION 12. APPROPRIATIONS - VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL TRAINING GRANTS.

33 ~~There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration~~  
 34 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State General Services Fund  
 35 Account, for grants to the Association of General Contractors to provide

1 training programs at Vocational Technical Schools for the biennial period

8 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - PUBLIC DEFENDER. The appropriation  
9 provided in Item (06) of Section 1 herein shall be expended only for the  
10 purpose of contracting with the Public Defender of Pulaski County to provide  
11 defense for the mentally ill. The appropriations made by Items (01), (05) and  
12 (09), of Section 1 are to provide state assistance grants to: (A) each  
13 Planning and Development District organized under Ark. Code §§14-166-201 et  
14 seq., and recognized by the Governor and, (B) locally formed organizations  
15 organized under The Interlocal Cooperation Act (Ark. Code §§25-20-101 et  
16 seq.), or other Acts which permit interstate cooperation among local  
17 governments and intrastate cooperation. Such grants are to be made in equal  
18 payments within each category of organization.

19

20 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - DISBURSING PROCEDURES. A lump sum  
21 monthly installment of 1/12 of the annual funded appropriation for the  
22 Arkansas Children's Hospital, as provided for in Section 2 of this Act, shall  
23 be provided to the Arkansas Children's Hospital by the Disbursing Officer for  
24 use in partial payment of the total annual cost of operations.

25

26 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - DISBURSING PROCEDURES.  
27 DFA/GRANTS-INDIGENT PATIENTS DISTRIBUTION. From the funds derived from the  
28 pari-mutuel tax on additional days of dog racing as authorized by law and  
29 deposited in the Indigent Patient's Fund, as authorized by Arkansas Code  
30 §§23-111-505, the following shall be made available each fiscal year:

31 (a) \$500,000 for defraying the cost of hospitalization and medical  
32 services of indigent Arkansas patients in out-of-state hospitals and may  
33 include provisions for non-emergency transportation for medical purposes.  
34 Provided however, that such transportation shall not exceed a 200 mile radius  
35 from the patient's point of origin.

1       (b) Funds in excess of \$500,000 shall be allotted to the Crittenden  
2 County EMS up to \$100,000 per fiscal year;

3       (c) Funds in excess of \$600,000 shall be allocated to fund any  
4 contract obligations over and above the total amount allowed in Section 3 Item  
5 (2) to defray the cost of hospitalization and medical services of  
6 indigent Arkansas patients in out-of-state hospitals, not to exceed  
7 \$200,000 per fiscal year;

8       (d) If there are funds available after the distributions have been  
9 made as specified in subsection (a), (b), and (c) above, the available  
10 amount shall be used for the support and operation of the Emergency  
11 Medical Services Programs of Cross, Lee, Mississippi, Poinsett, and St.  
12 Francis counties, not to exceed \$150,000 per fiscal year; and additional  
13 support for the Emergency Medical Services Program of Crittenden County, not  
14 to exceed \$50,000 per fiscal year;

15       (e) Upon receipt of said monies as allowed in subsection (d), the  
16 treasurer of each county shall deposit the same in a special account to be  
17 known as the "County Emergency Medical Services Fund", to be  
18 used for providing emergency medical services within those counties in  
19 accordance with appropriations made therefore by the quorum court of the  
20 appropriate county; and

21       (f) In the event there are funds remaining after the distributions have  
22 been made as specified in subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d) herein, the  
23 balance shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year to be used for the  
24 same purposes.

25

26       SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - JUVENILE TRANSPORTATION. Funds  
27 appropriated in Section 7 of this Act shall be used to provide  
28 grants/reimbursements to counties and cities for transportation of juvenile  
29 offenders to appropriate care or custody facilities or any other licensed  
30 juvenile facility approved by the court or as may be provided by law, in those  
31 counties which have juvenile detention facilities. Such grants/reimbursements  
32 for juvenile transportation costs shall be made in accordance with procedures  
33 and criteria developed and administered by the Office of Criminal Detention  
34 Facilities Review Coordinator.

35

1       SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION. A lump sum  
2 monthly installment of at least one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual appropriation  
3 provided for in Section 5 of this Act, or so much thereof as may be made  
4 available, shall be provided to the Arkansas Sheriffs Association to be used  
5 exclusively for the establishment and operation of crime prevention and  
6 alcohol and drug abuse programs.

7  
8       SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The annual assessed contribution payments  
9 for the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), appropriated in Item  
10 (02) of Section 11, shall be paid on a quarterly basis subject to a quarterly  
11 review by the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tem regarding NCSL's  
12 responsiveness to requests by the Arkansas General Assembly. If both the  
13 Speaker of the House and President Pro Tem of the Senate favorably review the  
14 performance of NCSL, and approve the quarterly payment, then the payment may  
15 be released to NCSL.

16  
17       SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation  
18 Commission shall establish such rules as necessary to ensure that the  
19 appropriation provided in Section 6 shall be utilized for the development and  
20 implementation of a beaver control program for those districts wishing to  
21 implement such a program.

22  
23       SECTION 20. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 413 of 1997,  
24 five million dollars (\$5,000,000) per year shall be set aside and used solely  
25 to provide for grants or loans to assist in the construction of natural gas  
26 projects. The Economic Development of Arkansas Fund Commission shall  
27 establish the rules and regulations for the distribution of funds for grants  
28 and loans to assist in the construction of natural gas projects appropriated  
29 in Act 413 of 1997 and as set aside by the provisions in this Act. The Joint  
30 Energy Committee shall review the rules and regulations of the Commission and  
31 shall review all proposals for the proposed natural gas projects grants and  
32 loans. Provided however, if the distribution is a grant the public purpose  
33 must be certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State before funds are  
34 disbursed.

1       SECTION 21. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance  
2 and Administration-Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General  
3 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the purchase of  
4 equipment for the City of Strong Fire Department, the sum of \$20,000.

5

6       SECTION 22. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance  
7 and Administration-Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General  
8 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for constructing and  
9 equipping the City of Hughes Fire Department, the sum of \$50,000.

10

11       SECTION 23. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance  
12 and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General  
13 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the purchase of  
14 equipment for the Stuttgart Fire Department, the sum of \$40,000.

15

16       SECTION 24. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
17 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable  
18 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund account, for  
19 matching funds to be paid to the City of Conway for costs of a study to  
20 determine the feasibility of constructing a highway bypass, the sum of  
21 \$125,000.

22

23       SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
24 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
26 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
29 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
30 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

32

33       SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
35 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

1 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

6

7 SECTION 27. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
8 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the  
9 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11 SECTION 28. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

16

17 SECTION 29. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
18 with this Act are hereby repealed.

19

20 SECTION 30. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
21 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
22 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
23 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
