 35 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - BUFFALO GNAT CONTROL PROGRAM. The

1 Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo Gnat Control Program in Item (05) of
2 Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended only for the control of buffalo gnats
3 in the Arkansas counties of Miller, LaFayette, Little River and parts of
4 Hempstead.

5

6 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance
7 of appropriation provided in Section 6 of this Act, which remains at the close
8 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be carried forward and made
9 available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999.

10

11 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - SHOW PREMIUMS. The Executive Director
12 shall promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the
13 administration and distribution of the appropriations authorized by Section 19
14 herein.

15

16 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT. Funds
17 appropriated in Item (05) (06) and (07) of Section 19 of this act shall be
18 used to reimburse members of high school 4H clubs, high school FFA clubs and
19 Miss Arkansas Rodeo for expenses incurred while representing the State of
20 Arkansas at national conferences and events outside the State. The State 4H
21 Association and the State FFA Association shall receive funds appropriated for
22 expense reimbursement of student members but shall be limited to \$20,000 each,
23 or so much thereof that is available. Reimbursement of expenses for Miss
24 Arkansas Rodeo shall be limited to \$350 per year.

25

26 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
27 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
29 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
32 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
33 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35

1 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9

10 SECTION 26. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
11 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
12 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13

14 SECTION 27. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

19

20 SECTION 28. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

22

23 SECTION 29. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
24 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
25 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
26 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
