28	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Section 24-5-101(6) is hereby	y amended to :	read
29	as follows:		
30	"(6) 'Average compensation' means the average of the	highest annua	1
31	compensation paid a member during any period of forty-eight (48) thirty six		
32	(36) consecutive months of creditable service with a _state employer_, as the		
33	term _state employer_ is defined in § 24-2-401;"

35	SECTION 2. (a) Effective July 1, 1997, the monthly r	etirement ben	efit
36	payable to the retirees and beneficiaries of the Arkansas St.	ate Highway	

- 1 Employees' Retirement System who are entitled to receive an annuity for July
- 2 1997, shall be increased by two and two-tenths percent (2.2%) above the
- 3 <u>annuity such retiree or beneficiary received for June 1997.</u>
- 4 (b) The increase in benefits as provided in this section shall be added
- 5 to the annuity for the purpose of computing the annual post-retirement
- 6 increase as provided in § 24-5-119 (a) for the benefit re-determination July
- 7 1, 1997.

- 9 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 10 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 11 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 13 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 14 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 15 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 16 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 17 act are declared to be severable.

- 19 SECTION 5. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 20 hereby repealed, provided, none of the amendments contained in this Act are
- 21 intended to nor shall they be construed to amend or affect any of the state-
- 22 supported retirement system laws of this State, with the exception of the laws
- 23 pertaining to the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System.

- 25 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
- 26 Eighty-First General Assembly that the amendments contained in this Act are
- 27 necessary in order for the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
- 28 Department to continue to retain and recruit efficient and skilled employees;
- 29 that immediately decreasing the number of months from forty-eight to thirty-
- 30 six for the purposes of ascertaining "average compensation" for retirement
- 31 benefit purposes will greatly assist such retention and recruitment efforts;
- 32 that benefits provided to retirants and beneficiaries under the Arkansas State
- 33 Highway Employees' Retirement System are inadequate; and that an increase
- 34 should be provided as soon as practicable in order to avoid an undue hardship
- 35 to many such retirants and beneficiaries. Therefore, an emergency is hereby
- 36 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation
