19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20
21 SECTION 1. If the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology requires
22 a person to obtain an animal waste management plan, including any permit
23 applications, prepared by a registerd professional engineer, the person may
24 substitute a plan prepared under the supervision of a registered professional
25 engineer employed by one of the following agencies: a conservation district;
26 Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission; Natural Resources
27 Conservation Service; or the University of Arkansas Cooperative Extension
28 Service.

29
30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33
34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
