SECTION 4. EXTRA HELP - VETERANS HOME DIVISION. There is hereby

9 authorized, for the Department of Veteran Affairs - Veterans Home Division for

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the 2 Department of Veteran Affairs - Veterans Home Division, to be payable from 3 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Veteran 4 Affairs, for refunds of unused fees paid by residents of the Veterans Home for 5 the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following: 6 7 ITEM FISCAL YEARS NO. 1997-98 1998-99 9 (01) REFUNDS/REIMBURSEMENTS <u>2,262,526</u> \$ 2,304,464 10 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The funds appropriated herein for Aid to 11 12 County Veterans Service Offices may also be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs to pay expenses of County Veterans Service Officers for attending 14 regional or statewide training conferences approved by the Department of 15 Veterans Affairs and designed to provide better trained and qualified Veterans 16 Service Officers in the various counties. Any such expenses paid by the 17 Department of Veterans Affairs from funds appropriated herein shall be on the 18 same reimbursement basis as the reimbursement of state employees for expenses 19 incurred in attending their official business. Provided, no County Veterans 20 Service Officer shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for expenses 21 incurred in attending more than two (2) approved conferences per year, per 22 county. 23 24 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 25 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 27 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 30 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 31 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 33 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 34

35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

- 1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
- 2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
- 6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 8 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
- 9 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
- 10 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

11

- 12 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
- 13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
- 14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
- 15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
- 16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

17

- 18 SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
- 19 with this Act are hereby repealed.

20

- 21 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
- 22 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
- 23 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
- 24 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
- 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 26 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 27 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 28 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- 29 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
- 30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
- 31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.

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
