16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18	SECTION 1. Short Title. This act may be cited as the "Partial-Birth
19	Abortion Ban Act of 1997".
20	
21	SECTION 2. Definitions. As used in this act, "partial-birth abortion"
22	means an abortion in which the person performing the abortion partially
23	vaginally delivers a fetus resulting in the termination of the pregnancy or a
24	partial-birth abortion as defined by the United States Supreme Court in any
25	opinion issued after the effective date of this act.
26	
27	SECTION 3. Partial-birth abortion prohibited. Whoever intentionally
28	performs a partial-birth abortion shall be subject to disciplinary action by
29	the State Medical Board, except when the partial-birth abortion was necessary
30	to save the life of the woman upon whom it was performed or avert serious
31	health consequences to the woman. Disciplinary action taken by the State
32	Medical Board against a physician who violates this act shall include a fine
33	not greater than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or suspension of the
34	physician's license for a period not greater than one (1) year, or revocation
35	of the physician's license, as determined by the board.
36	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
