19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:		
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21	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby approp	riated, to the	
22	Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department, to be payable from the		
23	State Highway and Transportation Department Fund, for operating expenses of		
24	the Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department which shall be		
25	supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act		
26	648 of 1995, the following:

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2 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 3 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 5 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 8 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 9 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 14 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 15 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 2.1 22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 23 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 2.5 26 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 27 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 28 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 29 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 31 32 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 34 35 Eighty-First General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for

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1 the operations of the Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Dept. are, due
 2 to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas State Highway &
 3 Transportation Dept. to continue to provide essential governmental services;
 4 that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the
 5 Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Dept. to continue such services; and
 6 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm
 7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
11 passage and approval.
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
