20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-7-708 is amended to read as follows:	
23	"24-7-708. Conditions subjecting annuities to limitations.	
24	(a) If a retirant is an employee of a public employer whose employee	s
25	are covered by the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, then, for each	
26	twelve-month period ending June 30, the amount of his system annuity shall	be
27	subject to the limitations equivalent to twice the limitations imposed by the	he
28	social security retirement test.	
29	(b) For each year ending June 30, the social security retirement tes	t
30	to be considered shall be the test in effect for the calendar year beginning	g
31	the January 1 immediately preceding June 30. The retirant's earnings shall	be
32	his remuneration for such employment for the year ending June 30.	
33	(c) The board, by appropriate rules and regulations, shall establish	
34	equivalent limitations.	
35	(d) Receiving remuneration as an employee from any private employer	or

36 as a member of the General Assembly shall not affect payment of an annuity.

(e) During any period of employment in a position covered by the 2 system, a retirant shall not accrue additional credited service nor shall he 3 contribute to the system. 4 (f) If a retirant is employed in a covered position by a state college, 5 university, or vocational-technical school, his annuity shall not be subject 6 to the limitations imposed in subsection (a) of this section." 8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature 9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 12 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 18 19 hereby repealed. 2.0 21 SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the 22 Eighty-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain 23 occupational groups are exempt from the annuity limitation under the Teacher 24 Retirement System; that this exemption creates an inequitable situation with 25 other groups; and eliminating this exemption is essential to the equitable 26 administration of the retirement system. Therefore, in order to restore 27 equity among the groups under the system, an emergency is hereby declared to 28 exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the 29 public peace, health, and safety, shall become effective July 1, 1997. 30 31 32 33 34 35
