- 1 <u>§ 25-16-404. Biennial report.</u>
- 2 (a) It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to make a biennial
- 3 report to the Governor.
- 4 (b) The report shall contain a full record of the official and business
- 5 transactions of his office for the two (2) preceding years, together with any
- 6 statistical and historical information taken from the records and archives in
- 7 his office which will be useful and instructive to the citizens of the state.
- 8 (c) Until otherwise provided by law, there shall be published two
- 9 thousand (2,000) copies of the report, to be paid for out of the general
- 10 appropriation for printing and binding.

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- 12 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 13 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 14 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 16 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 17 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 18 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 20 act are declared to be severable.

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- 22 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 23 hereby repealed.

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- 25 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
- 26 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Office of Secretary of State should
- 27 not expend public funds for the publication of a synopsis of general laws nor
- 28 for publishing two thousand (2,000) copies of a biennial report of the
- 29 activities of the Governor's office. Therefore an emergency is declared to
- 30 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
- 31 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its
- 32 approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the
- 33 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time
- 34 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the
- 35 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the
- 36 last house overrides the veto.
