30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature 31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
