12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
25 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
26 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
27 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
28 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
29 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
30 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
31 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
32 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
33 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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6 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State
 7 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
 8 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 9 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein
 10 for such purposes: twenty (20) temporary or part-time employees, when needed,
 11 at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 12 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 13 classification.

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15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State
 16 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, to be
 17 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
 18 the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State
 19 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
 20 biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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1 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CARRY FORWARD. The remaining balance as
2 of June 30, 1998, of unexpended appropriation in Capital Outlay shall be
3 carried forward into fiscal year 1998-99 to be used for the same purpose for
4 the next fiscal year.

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6 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
7 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
9 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
12 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
13 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
18 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
19 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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29 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
30 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
32 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
33 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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35 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict

1 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.

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
